

Sample CP AoR preparedness and response plan

Many of the below actions require ACCESS and electricity which will not be available

Note that Yaroub Ismail is CP AoR coordinator Rakhine <u>yismail@unicef.org</u> – all activities should be coordinated through Yaroub

1. Pre-disaster

- Identify psychological first aid staffs or community volunteers in anticipated affected area
- Share key preparedness messages with children, caregivers and communities
- Map existing stock and human resources
- Ensure emergency phone numbers are available in case of child protection concern identified by other clusters
- Identify community members for temporary emergency care in case of separation
- Identification of agency to undertake FTR (properly skilled in safe FTR)

2. Within 72 hours of disaster

- CP AoR ad hoc coordination meeting ASAP
- CP actors engaged in rapid need assessment (RNA) to be mobilized and deployed
- UASC identified and rapid reunification undertaken where possible
- Temporary care for UASC identified and utilized
- Key CP messages (1 day after) disseminated
- Child and Caregiver "help desks" set up with child friendly space for rapid reunification
- Update sent to national CP AoR (reporting template shared) and OCHA sitrep

3. 72 hours to 1 week

- Deployment of additional CP staff as needed
- Establishment of temporary CFS (mobile)
- Distribution off CP Kits
- FTR process undertaken (partners to use excel in encrypted emails to identified focal point to undertake FTR)
- Provide psychological first aid (PFA), link affected people to appropriate services provider
- MHPSS provided (group and individual) to children and caregivers
- Awareness raising on Key CP messages and MHPSS messages
- Case management actors deployed
- Training on CPiE (short orientation online) for partners to be on the same page
- Daily update to national CP AoR and OCHA sitrep

4. 1 week to 2 weeks

- Child Protection assessment training
- Child protection assessment
- Ongoing activities as above
- Finding shared with national CP AoR
 Update to national CP AoR twice per week
